As attested by his published articles, he has collaborated with universities and institutions, such as Karolinska Institutet, Johns Hopkins University, Uppsala Universitet, INSERM - Sorbonne Université (Paris), Université de Lausanne, Medizinische Universität Wien, Cochrane UK Centre, World Cancer Research Fund (WCRF), Childhood Leukemia International Consortium (CLIC) etc. He has received national and international prizes for his scientific achievements, including an Award from the Academy of Athens.
